

ANNEX C
To AKZO NOBLE PRIVACY CODE OF CONDUCT
Concerning Supplier Data

In this Annex the definitions as used in the AKZO NOBEL PRIVACY CODE OF CONDUCT shall have the same meaning. Supplier in this context shall be Data Subject.

1. Supplier Data may be used for:

- a. The exercise of the objects of the Akzo Nobel Group;
- b. For purchasing purposes.

2. Supplier Data may include:

- a. First name, surname, initials, title, gender, nationality, date and place of birth, address, postcode, domicile, telephone number and similar communication details, bank account number of the Supplier;
- b. An administration number containing no more details as meant under a.;
- c. Other data as mentioned under a, which require processing pursuant to the application of other legislation.

3. Access to the Supplier Data may be obtained by:

- a. For the exercise of the objects of the Akzo Nobel Group
 - such Employees, Processors and Third Parties as shall be designated
- b. For purchasing purposes to purchasing managers
 - such specific persons or staff and category of persons or staff as designated.

4. Storage Period:

The Storage Period of Supplier Data shall be:

- a. no longer than the time necessary to achieve the objects of the Akzo Nobel Group;
- b. after the applicable Storage Period has lapsed, Personal Data may – to the extent reasonably necessary – only be kept for archive purposes.
