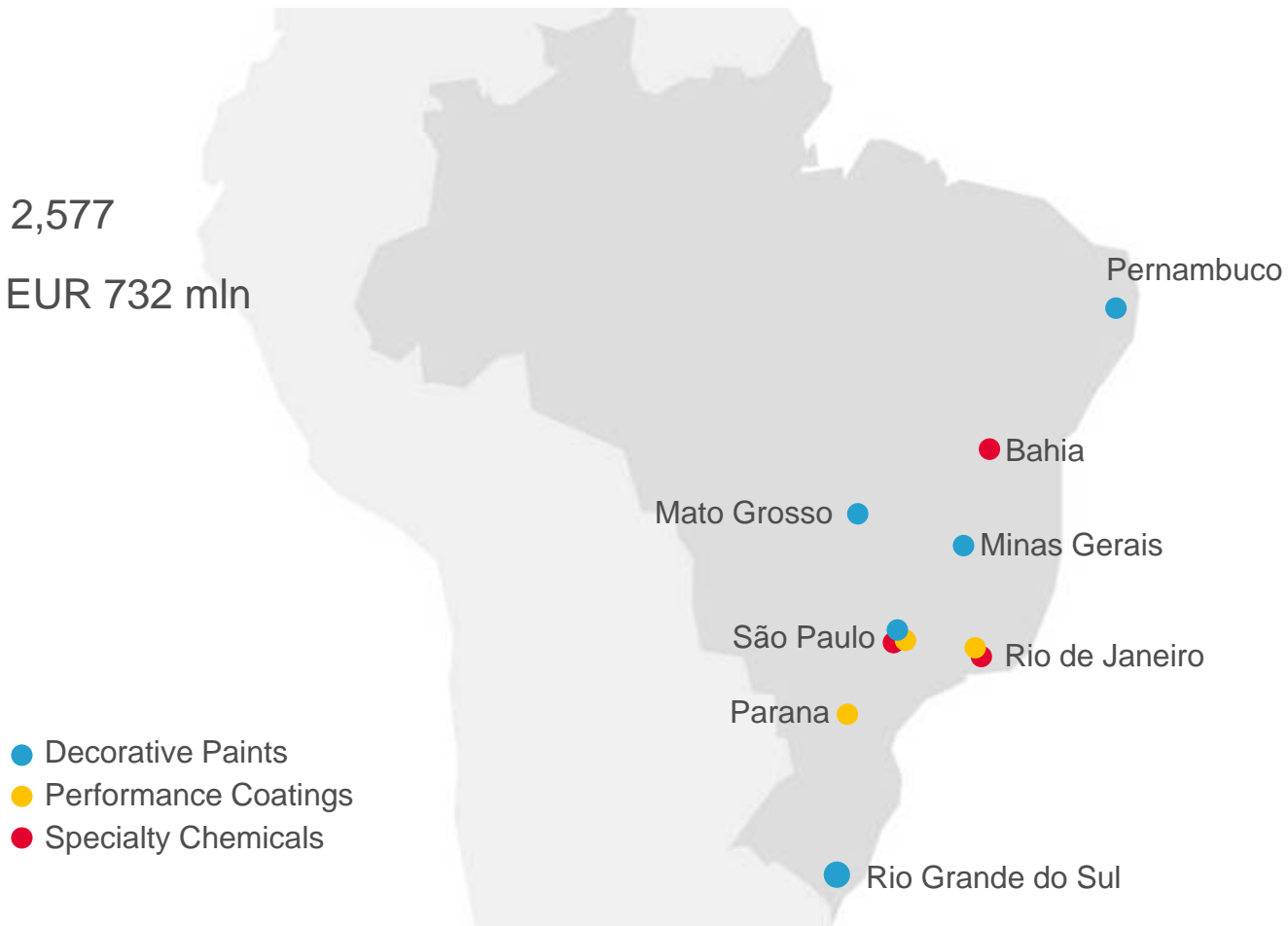

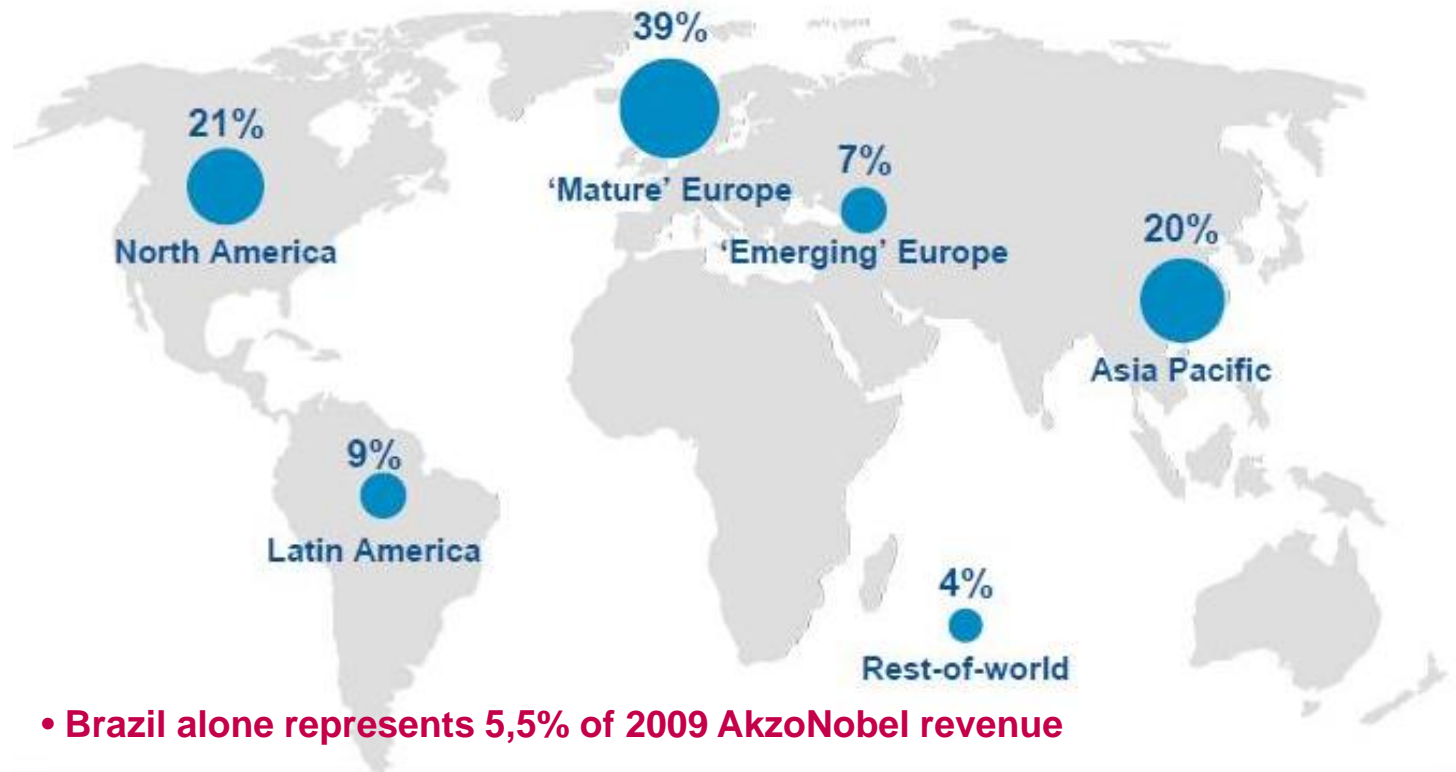

High-growth markets are important (37% of revenue)

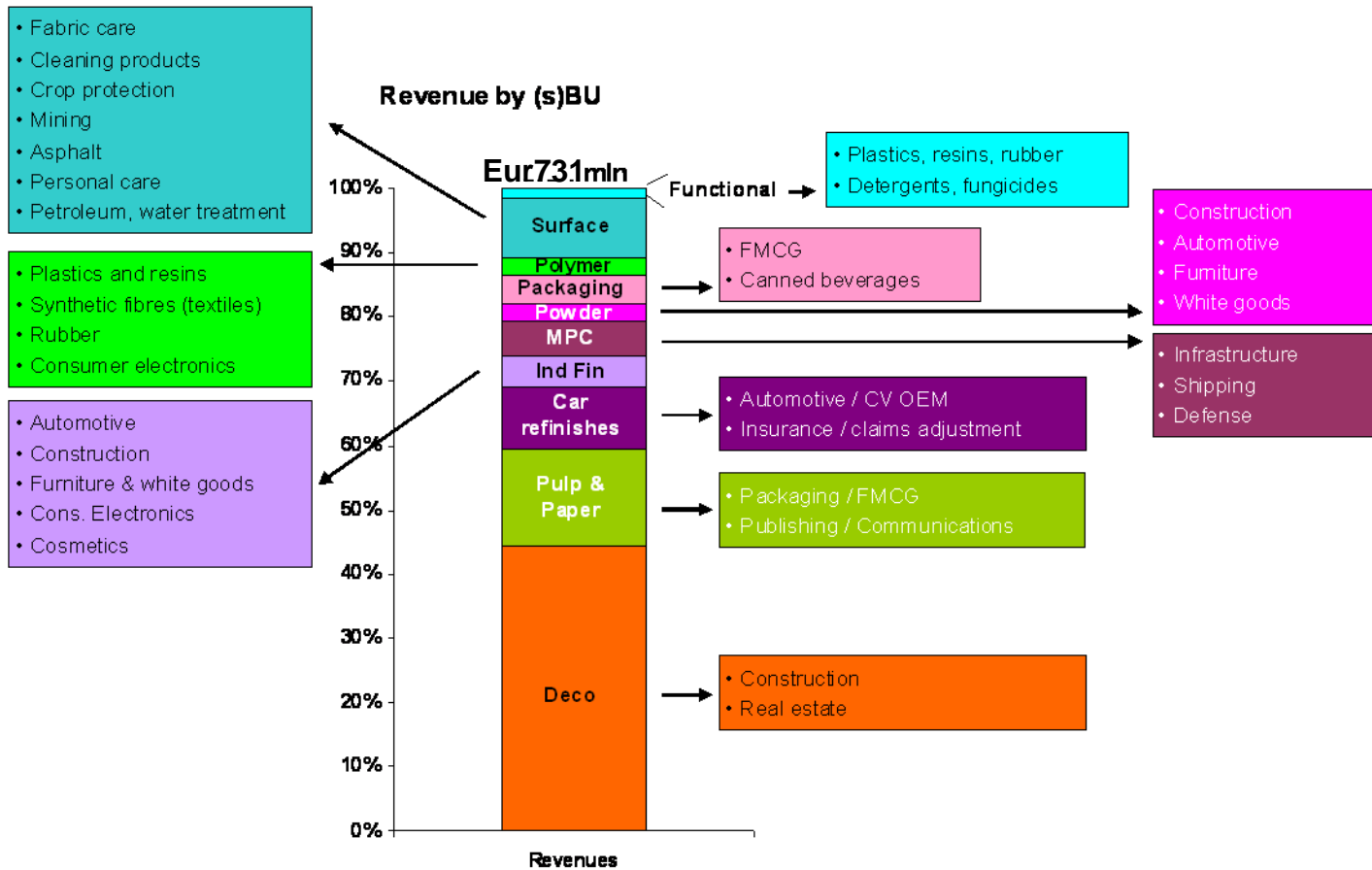
% of 2009 revenue



High-growth markets profitability is above average

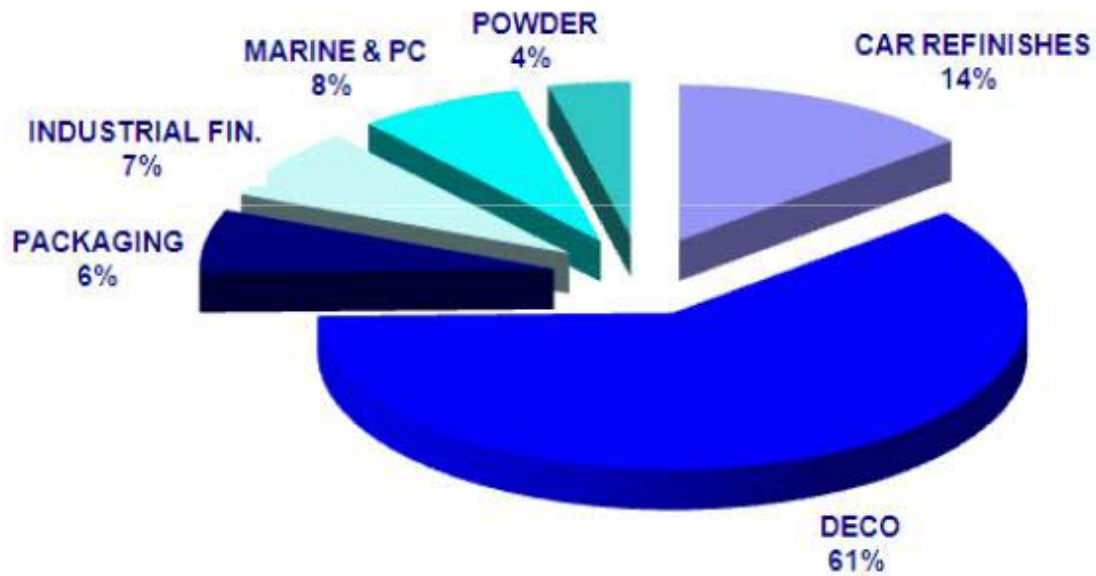

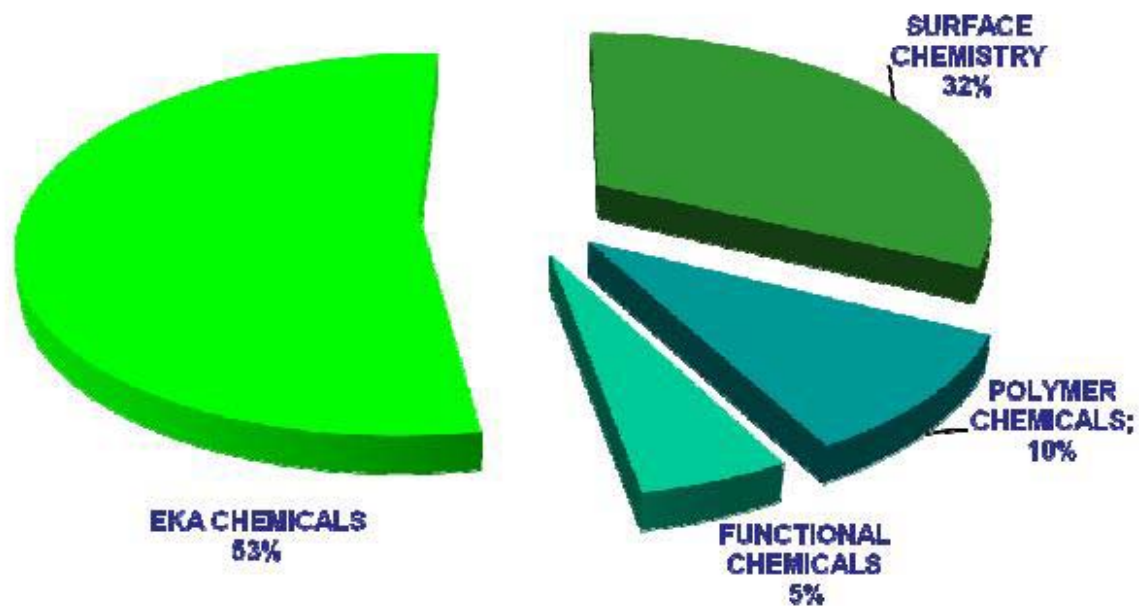
2009 Coatings Revenue Split

Surfactants is a major supplier of agricultural adjuvants, amongst other used in anti rust treatment for soy crops

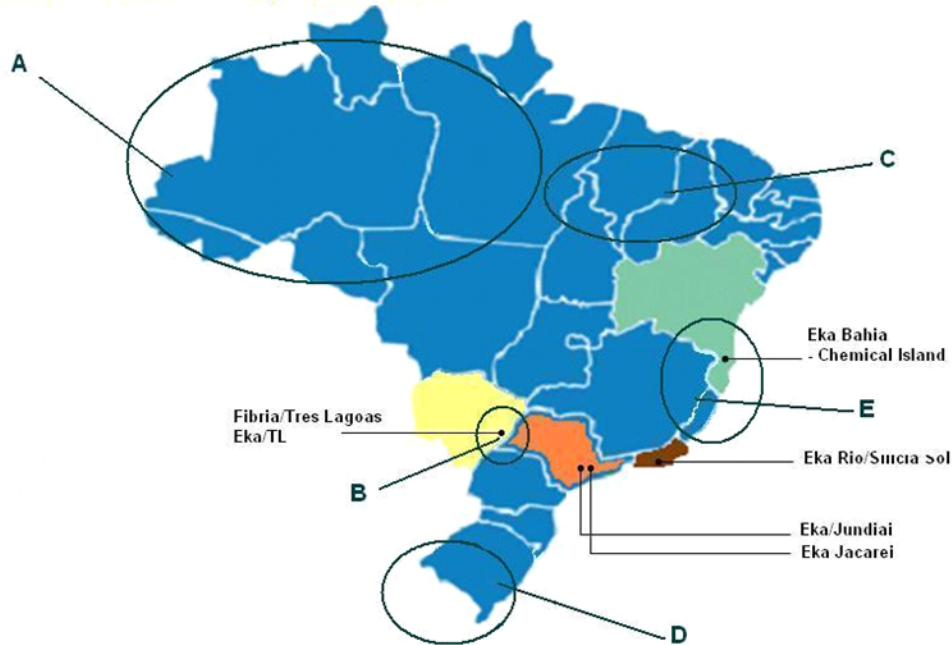
