Purpose			
This Directive ensures that AkzoNobel complies with all applicable Competition laws.			
Scope and definitions			
<p>This Directive applies to business unit, Functional and country management (“Management”) in particular and all employees in general.</p> <p>“Competition laws” are all rules and regulations prohibiting agreements, practices and conduct that have a detrimental effect on competition (such as price-fixing or collusion between competitors or abuse of a dominant position) which can lead to higher prices, lower output and restrict innovation and technical development.</p> <p>“Designated Employees” are employees who (i) have contact with customers, agents, distributors, suppliers and/or competitors (including those employees that attend trade association meetings or trade fairs); (ii) have management responsibilities in respect of any such employee; or (iii) hold an executive position in any business or function or assist such executive position.</p>			
Directives			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Employees shall comply with all applicable competition laws, as well as the Rules on Competition law compliance (“Rules”), the Competition law compliance Manual (“Manual”) and accompanying Guidelines.</li> <li>2. Management is responsible for compliance with all applicable competition laws, as well as the Rules, Manual and Guidelines</li> <li>3. Management will ensure that Designated Employees complete competition law training as set forth in the Rules</li> <li>4. Management will ensure that Designated Employees complete the annual competition law compliance declaration as set forth in the Rules</li> <li>5. The Standard Amnesty Program (as defined in the Rules) will be conducted at newly acquired businesses</li> <li>6. Management will ensure that ALG Global Director Competition Law shall be immediately informed about, manage and participate in all communications to or from competition authorities</li> <li>7. ALG shall be responsible for retaining and managing external counsel for Competition law matters.</li> </ol>
