Dr. Müller has extensive leadership experience in the chemicals industry. He served as CEO at Azelis Group N.V. for over ten years. Prior to that, he was a member of the Executive Board at Clariant AG and COO at Süd-Chemie AG. Dr. Müller held various management positions at BASF AG, where he started his career as a research chemist. He studied chemistry at the Ludwig-Maximilians-University in Munich, where he received a doctorate in metal-organic chemistry. He also completed postdoctoral studies at the University of California/Los Angeles as well as various management programs.

In accordance with the articles of association of Akzo Nobel N.V., Dr. Müller is nominated by the Supervisory Board for appointment as a member of AkzoNobel's Supervisory Board for a first four-year term, with effect from April 25, 2025.

On April 25, 2025, Dr. Müller will comply with all relevant regulations for appointment as a member of the Supervisory Board.
